WE ARE A MEMBER OF THE NATIONAL TRAFFIC SYSTEM AND OPERATE ON A FREQUENCY OF 3921 KILOHERTZ. YOUR NET CONTROL TODAY IS _____, MY NAME IS _____ AND I AM LOCATED AT _____.

ALL STATIONS ARE ASKED TO PLEASE TUNE TO MY FREQUENCY.

FOLLOWING THE INITIAL CALL FOR CHECK-INS, ADDITIONAL CHECK-INS ARE ASKED TO PLEASE WAIT FOR ONE OF THE STANDBYS GIVEN EVERY TEN MINUTES FOR THAT PURPOSE. HOWEVER, MOBILES AND STATIONS WITH TRAFFIC ARE ENCOURAGED TO CHECK IN AT ANY TIME, NOT JUST AT STANDBY. TRAFFIC WILL BE LISTED AT EACH STANDBY. TRAFFIC AND MOBILES WILL BE GIVEN PRIORITY IN TRANSMISSION.

PLEASE GIVE YOUR NAME AND LOCATION WHEN YOU MAKE YOUR TRANSMISSION

-RECOGNIZE THE PRE-NET GROUP

-CALL FOR STATIONS WITH TRAFFIC

-CALL FOR MOBILE STATIONS

-CALL FOR ANY OTHER CHECK-INS WITH OR WITHOUT TRAFFIC.

-MOBILES ALWAYS HAVE THE FIRST TRANSMISSION FOLLOWED BY THE HAM OF THE MONTH, THEN HAM OF THE YEAR.

-PLEASE LIMIT NET CONTROL STATION COMMENTS TO THE NET RUNS ALONG BRISKLY. TRY TO GET AT LEAST 15 TRANSMISSIONS IN BY 5:30 P.M.

-IN- AND-OUT STATIONS ARE NOT GIVEN TRANSMISSION ON THE REGULAR NET
