



U. P. NET MEMBER PROFILE W8JNL, JIM LOVE GLADSTONE MI

I was born in Coldwater MI, on September 10, 1946. I graduated from Manistique High School in 1964. In 1969 I received a Bachelor's of Arts degree from Northern Michigan University with a major in Biology and a minor in Conservation.

My Dad worked for General Telephone Co., so I lived in Coldwater, Williamston, Grand Ledge, Manistique, Marquette, and Gladstone.

I retired from Mead Westvaco Corporation in March of 2005 after almost 32 years in the paper industry. Before that I worked as a branch manager for Lynn Auto parts in Manistique.

I married Mary K Bonifas on September 9, 1972 in Manistique. Mary is a retired LPN. We have two daughters. Dawn is a RN in Green Bay, and is a nursing supervisor and emergency room nurse at St. Mary's Hospital. Jacqueline is a grad of Northern Michigan University who has worked 13 years for Adult Learning Systems as a manager of a home for patients with mental problems. Jacque has recently moved home and is enrolled in Bay de Nocs's nursing program to become an RN.

I first got interested in radio putting together a few radio kits with my Dad in the late 50's and early 60's. I didn't get back into radios until the mid 70's when I went to work for Mead Corporation. We used commercials radios to dispatch our pulpwood truck fleet and to contact the various timber producers who worked for us. In 1999, Howard St. John, W8HSJ, and I started to work on the same job and Howard got me interested in Ham Radio. In 2008, after I retired, I passed my Tech in April and my General in July.

My rig is an Icom 756 PRO with matching power supply and a SM 20 microphone. I recently purchased a used Ameritron AL-80A amplifier and just purchased a MFJ 989D Versa TurnerV. I have a 48 foot Rohn tower with a Hy-Gain TH-3MK4 Tri band beam for 20/15/10. I also have a Hy-Gain VB-25FM 2 meter 5 element beam, an Alpha Delta DXLB shortened multi-band dipole for 160, 80, 40, 20, 15, and 10, and a Radio Wavz OCF Dipole DX-80. My 2 meter rig in the shack is a Yaesu FT2900 with a MFJ4245MV power supply and a J pole. In the car there is a Yaesu FT2800 with a 5/8 wave antenna.

Other hobbies include wood working, photography, reading, and listening to musice.
