- •A small program on the MI computer notifies them of any IP address changes.
- •I can then use a proxy for the numerical Michigan IP address:

- •Xxxxxxx.dyndns.org:portxxxx

- •MI Router Port Forwarding for AC power strip and Real VNC.
- •MI Firewall Exceptions for Real VNC and Skype
- Assign static LAN IP's to MI Computer and AC power strip –disable DHCP
